

## 2019 Artisans Market

The Washunga Days Artisans Market is a unique outdoor market that will take place during the Washunga Days festival. The festival has been held annually for over 35 years and draws over 5,000 people each year.

The Artisans Market is a juried event accepting vendors based on variety, originality and quality of goods.

We are currently accepting applications from vendors specializing in handmade, repurposed and unique items. Vendor selection is designed to provide customers a wide range of selections and to ensure our vendors have a successful market experience.

The market will be held at the Neosho Riverwalk Park (the festival grounds) from 11am-4:30pm on Saturday, June 22<sup>nd</sup>.

## **Market Information:**

- The market is outdoors, please be prepared for the heat/sun with an awning, canopy or tent.
- In case of high winds, please come prepared with tent weights.
- The surface is grass and not completely flat.
- Electricity will NOT be available.
- Booth size is 10x10.
- Registration fee is \$20.
- Set up will be Saturday, June 22<sup>nd</sup> at 8:30am.
- Market hours are 11am-4:30pm- we ask vendors do not take down until 4:30pm.

## **Process:**

- Vendor applications must be completed by May 25<sup>th</sup>.
- Refund deadline is May 30<sup>th</sup>. If you are selected as a vendor and cancel past this date, we will not issue a refund for your registration fee.
- Vendors can submit information in the form at <u>washungadays.com/artisansmarket</u>
- Please include specific details about your items and a website link to your items in the form if possible.
- The jury process begins once you submit your form. You may be asked to submit pictures of your work for the jury process.
- If you are selected for the market, you will be notified and sent a registration link to pay for your vendor fee and reserve your spot.
- Once you are selected you will get set up and tear down information closer to the event.
